5 WAYS TO SELF-DESTRUCT

(a warning; not a recommendation)

INTRODUCTION

We say, "I did that to myself" "It's my own fault" "I have only myself to blame"

God's prophet, Hosea, confirms this thought of self-destruction.

- (13:9) "O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself, but in Me is thine help"
- (14:1) "O Israel, return unto the Lord thy God, for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity"
- (7:2) "... their own doings have beset them ... "
- (8:3) "Israel hast cast off the thing that is good: the enemy shall pursue them"
- (10:13) "Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped iniquity"

The thought is true in our spiritual life, too:

(Prov. 6:27-28) "Can a man take fire in his bosom, and his clothes not be burned? ... "
(Gal. 6:7-8) "... for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap ... "
(Romans 6:17-18) "... his servants ye are to whom ye obey ... "

HOW DO WE DO IT TO OURSELVES?

1. SINS (Prov. 8:36) "he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul ... "

(Isa. 59:1-2) "... your iniquities have separated between you and your God ... "
(Hosea 13:9) "... but in Me is thine help" - we do not have to let sin destroy us.
(Titus 2:11; 1 Cor. 10:13; 2 Peter 1:4-8)

2. SPEECH

(Matt. 12:36-37) "... for by thy words thou shalt be justified ... be condemned" (Eph. 4:29) "Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth ... "

3. PRIDE

(Prov. 16:18) "Pride goes before destruction, an haughty spirit before a fall"

(Prov. 15:25) "The Lord will destroy the house of the proud"

(Prov. 29:23) "A man's pride shall being him low"

4. LACK OF KNOWLEDGE

(Hosea 4:6) "My people are destroyed for a lack of knowledge" ... hast rejected knowledge" (John 6:45; Acts 17:11; 1 Thess. 5:21; 2 Tim. 2:15)

5. PREJUDICE (Matt. 13:15) "their eyes they have closed ... and should be converted ... "

(1 Tim. 2:3-4) " ... who would have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth"
