INTRODUCTION

(Heb. 12:3) "For consider Him that endured ..."

"consider" - deliberation, ponder, contemplate, examine, careful thought, take into account.

1. CONSIDER HIS PURPOSE IN COMING INTO THE WORLD

(Luke 2:11; Matt. 1:21)

(Luke 19:10) "the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost"

2. CONSIDER HIS KNOWLEDGE OF WHAT HE WOULD ENDURE

(Matt. 20:17-19)

The future crucifixion was not a surprise to Jesus.

3. CONSIDER JESUS WILLINGLY GOING TO THAT CROSS

(Matt. 20:28) "the Son of man came ... to give His life a ransom for many"

(John 10:17-18; Phil. 2:8; John 18:2-11)

4. CONSIDER JESUS' SILENCE BEFORE HIS ACCUSERS

(Isaiah 53:7) "... He opened not His mouth ..."

(Matt. 26:62-66; Luke 23:9; Matt. 27:14; Acts 8:33)

5. CONSIDER JESUS' AGONY ON THE CROSS

6. CONSIDER JESUS' CONCERN FOR OTHERS

(John 19:27; Luke 23:34; Romans 5:8-10)

7. CONSIDER JESUS' RESURRECTION: (Matt. 28:5-6; 1 Cor. 15:11-22)

8. CONSIDER JESUS' ASCENSION TO HEAVEN: (Eph. 1:20-23, 5:23)

9. CONSIDER JESUS' COMING AGAIN: (Acts 17:30-31)
