"Sacrifice" is good, needed, not eliminated; however, there is something "better."

- 1. (Proverbs 21:3) "To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice"

 (Jer. 9:24; Isaiah 1:11; Micah 6:6-8; Matt. 23:23; John 7:24; Matt. 7:2)
- 2. (Mark 12:33) "... and to love him ... is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifice"
 - (1 Cor. 13:1-3) ... and have not charity, it profits me nothing"
 - (1 Tim. 1:5; Romans 13:8)
- 3. (Hosea 6:6) "For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings"

(Micah 6:8; Micah 7:18; James 2:13)

4. (Hosea 6:6) "For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings"

(Hosea 4:1; Hosea 4:6; 2 Peter 3:18; 1 Peter 2:2)

5. (Psalm 69:30-31) "I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving. This also shall please the Lord better than an ox or bullock that has horns and hoofs"

(Psalm 116:17) (Hebrews 13:15) "offer the sacrifice of praise"

6. (Psalm 51:16-17) "For you desire not sacrifice; else would I give it: You delight not in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise"

7. (1 Sam. 15:22) "And Samuel said, Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams"
