INTRODUCTION

We stand in need of God's forgiveness: (Romans 3:10, v23)

Sin defined: "to miss the mark or target" (James 2:9; James 4:17; 1 John 3:4; 1 John 5:17)

WHAT DOES GOD DO WITH OUR SINS?

- 1. (Psalm 32:1) "Blessed is he whose **transgression is forgiven ...**" (Psalm 103:2-3; Jeremiah 31:34)
- 2. (Psalm 32:1) "Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered" (Psalm 85:2)
- 3. (Psalm 25:11) "For thy name's sake, O Lord, pardon my iniquity; for it is great"
- 4. (Psalm 103:12) "As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed my transgression from me" How far is that?
- (Job 14:17) "My transgression is sealed up in a bag, and thou sewest up mine iniquity"
 That's better than a double-lock, zip-lock, baggie.
- 6. (Isaiah 38:17) "... but thou hast in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for thou hast cast all my sins behind thy back" God cannot see them any more.
- 7. (Isaiah 43:25) "I, even I, am he that blots out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins" (also Psalm 51:9; Acts 3:19)
- 8. (Isaiah 43:25) "... and will **not remember thy sins"** (Heb. 8:12; Heb. 10:17; Jeremiah 31:34)
- 9. (Micah 7:18-19) "Who is a God like unto thee, that pardons iniquity ... and thou will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea" they are gone.
- 10. (Matthew 26:28) "For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for **the remission of sins**" (Acts 2:38) "remission of sins"
