## THE 6 "WHEREIN"S OF MALACHI (KJV)

INTRODUCTION - Malachi's message provides a summary of Israel's rebellion against God, and it is timely for God's people today.

(1:1-2) "The burden of the word of the Lord to Israel by Malachi, I have loved you, says the Lord.
 Yet ye say, Wherein ("in what way") hast thou loved us?"

Israel has a short memory: they've forgotten God's promises, leadership, and providence. Is our memory short?

God's love is proven in grace: (John 15:13; Romans 5:8; Ephesians 1:3) We cannot plead ignorance of God's love toward us.

2. (1:6) "A son honors his father, and a servant his master. If then I am the Father, Where is My honor? and if I am a Master, where is My reverence? Says the Lord of hosts unto you, O priests, who despise My name. Yet ye say, Wherein ("in what way") have we despised Thy name?"

Malachi gives two illustrations of "honor" desired by God: "a son" and "a servant" God's name is "despised" when "honor" is withheld.

"Honor" - public acknowledgement or admiration; glorify; show appreciation; to give credit.

3. (1:7) "Ye offer polluted bread upon My altar; and ye say, Wherein have we polluted Thee?"

"Polluted bread" - bread that was old, stale, crusty, and left-over.

(v8) "you offer the blind as a sacrifice ... offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? ... "

Will we offer God a "polluted" life? - the left-overs, less than our best, no diligence

(Ecclesiastes 12:1; Ecclesiastes 9:10; 2 Peter 1:5-11)

- 4. (2:17) "You have wearied the Lord with your words. Yet you say, Wherein have we wearied Him?"
  - (v2) "If ye will not hear, and if ye will not take it to heart, to give glory to My name ... "

(v8) "But you have departed from the way; you have many to stumble ... "

(v14) " ... the wife of your youth, with whom you have dealt treacherously ... "

- (v17) "In that you say, Everyone who does evil is good in the sight of the Lord, delights in them"
- 5. (3:7) "Yet from the days of your fathers you have gone away from My ordinances, and not kept them. Return to Me, and I will return to you. Yet ye say, Wherein shall we return?"

God wants them to listen to Moses and the prophets, heed the ordinances (the Law), and return. God offers to us a gracious way in which to "return."

6. (3:8) "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me.

But ye say, Wherein have we robbed You? In tithes and offerings ... "

They were habitual in giving God "pollution;" therefore, it's not surprising they withheld treasure.

"Tithe" - the 10<sup>th</sup> part to be given to the Lord (Leviticus 27:30)

"Offerings" - other offerings were required throughout the year.

God's promise: (Malachi 3:10)

For us:

Our treasure: (2 Corinthians 9:6-8)

Our offerings: time, talent, service, example, ministry: (Matthew 5:16)
