DAILY CHRISTIANITY

(Acts 2:36 – 47)

INTRODUCTION - “7 days without Christ makes one **weak.**”

1. DAILY PRAYER

Jesus taught to include in prayer: (Luke 11:3) “Give us day by day our **daily** bread”  
Remember to say, “Thank you” - (Psalm 68:19) “Blessed be the Lord, who **daily** loads us  
with benefits, the God of our salvation.”  
(1 Thessalonians 5:17) “Pray without ceasing”

2. DAILY BIBLE STUDY

Moses gave a practical application of how to do this: (Deuteronomy 6:6-9)  
(Acts 17:11) “ ... they received the word with all readiness, and **searched the Scriptures daily**  
to find out whether these things were so.”

3. DAILY EVANGELISM

(Luke 19:47) “And He was **teaching daily** in the temple ... “  
(Acts 5:42) “And **daily** in the temple, and in every house, they did not cease teaching  
and preaching Jesus as the Christ.”  
We strive to get the message out: Bible class, worship assembly, sermon outline, web site,  
mission efforts, individual contact with family and friends.

4. DAILY EXHORTATION

(Hebrews 3:13) “but **exhort one another daily**, while it is called Today ... “  
Start here in Bible class and worship assembly, in the foyer and parking lot, make the visit,  
send the card or e-mail, and (1 Thess. 5:14) “Now we exhort you, brethren,  
warn those who are unruly, comfort the faint-hearted, uphold the weak, patient to all”

5. DAILY MINISTRATION

(Acts 6:1-7) a conflict arose in the church at Jerusalem (v1) “ ... because their widows  
were neglected in the **daily distribution.**”  
There will always be opportunity to help others in need of food, clothing, and shelter.  
(Matthew 26:11 and 25:31-46; Galatians 2:10 and 6:10; James 1:27)

6. DAILY CROSS-BEARING

(Luke 9:23) “Then He said to them all, If anyone desires to come after Me, let him  
deny himself, and **take up his cross daily**, and follow Me.”  
(Matthew 10:38) “And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me  
is not worthy of Me.”

CLOSE - the church gathers in assembly, and the church scatters; you are still the church.
