GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

INTRODUCTION

"Faithful" - reliable; trust-worthy; dependable; fidelity; do what's promised.
(Titus 1:2 "God, who cannot lie" (Hebrews 6:18) "impossible for God to lie")

"Unfaithful" - can't be trusted, or counted on, and is not reliable.

(Psalm 89:8) "O Lord God of hosts, who is mighty like You, O Lord?
Your faithfulness surrounds You."

1. GOD'S FAITHFULNESS IN CREATION

(Genesis 1:1) "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth"
(v12, v17, v21, 25) "and God saw that it was good"
(v31) "and indeed it was very good"

(Hebrews 11:3) "the worlds were framed by the word of God"
(Psalm 119:90) "You established the earth, and it abides"
(Colossians 1:17) "in Him all things consist ("hold together")"
(Genesis 8:22) "While the earth remains ... shall not cease."

2. GOD'S FAITHFULNESS FOR ME MEANS (for all Christians)

(Psalm 8:3-4) "When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars which You have ordained, what is man that You are mindful of him?"

1) I will strive to be faithful to God.

(1 Corinthians 15:58) "be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing your labor is not in vain in the Lord"
(Hebrews 10:23) "Hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, **for He who promised is faithful ...**"
(Revelation 22:6; Numbers 23:19; Deuteronomy 7:9)

2) I have faith that God answers prayer - (Jeremiah 33:3)

(Psalm 143:1) (NIV) "Lord, hear my prayer, listen to my cry for mercy; **in Your faithfulness and righteousness come to my relief**"

3. I can pray for deliverance from temptations.

(2 Peter 2:9; 2 Thessalonians 3:3; Matthew 6:13; 1 Corinthians 10:13)

4. I want to thank God for His faithfulness.

(Psalm 92:1-2; Psalm 119:62; Joshua 23:14)

5. I believe in a heaven for me. (John 14:1-3; Titus 1:2)
