"LITTLE" THINGS?

(Ephesians 4:25 – 32)

INTRODUCTION: (Zechariah 4:10) "For who has despised the day of small things?"

1. ACTS OF KINDNESS

1. Your kindness should be genuine and not superficial.
2. Kindness involves the way we think: (Proverbs 4:23 and 23:7)
3. Kindness looks for virtues and not flaws.
4. Kindness does not search for things to criticize.
5. Kindness is not a rule by which we live; rather, it is the life we live.

2. (Matthew 10:42) "... ONLY A CUP OF COLD WATER ... " (Hebrews 6:9-12)

3. LIFE (ACTIVITY) IN THE CONGREGATION

4. SAYING, "THANK YOU"

- 1) to God for bountiful daily blessings: (Psalm 103:2) "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits."
- 2) to one another for their acts of kindness. Good manners.

5. COMFORTING OTHERS IN THEIR AFFLICTION

(2 Corinthians 1:3-4) "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of comfort, who comforts us in all our afflictions, that we may be able to comfort those who are in trouble ... "

6. HOSPITALITY: Titus 1:8; 1 Peter 4:9)

7. TALENTS: (1 Corinthians 12:12 – 31) (v21) "And the eye cannot say to the hand, 'I have no need of you' ... "

8. NO SUCH THING AS A "LITTLE" SIN: (1 Corinthians 5:6)
(2 Kings 10:18; Song of Solomon 2:15; Ecclesiastes 10:1)

CLOSE: Your decision to become a Christian is not a "little" thing.
