KNOW GOD AN ETERNAL GOD

INTRODUCTION

"Eternal" - everlasting; without end; infinite; perpetuity (perpetual); timeless;
is not temporary; forever and always will be; will not go away.

(Numbers 23:19) **"God is not a man, that He should lie,
Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do?
Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?"**

(Deuteronomy 33:26) **"There is no one like the God of Jeshurun (name of tribe),
who rides the heavens to help you ... the eternal God is your refuge ... "**

(Isaiah 57:15) **"For thus says the High and Lofty One who inhabits eternity,
whose name is Holy: I dwell in the high and holy place ... "**

(Isaiah 44:6) **"Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer,
the Lord of hosts: I am the First and I am the Last; besides Me there is no God."**

1. IN CONTRAST, WE HAVE A LIFE-SPAN

(James 1:9-10) **"Let the lowly brother glory in his exaltation, but the rich man
in his humiliation, because as the flower of the field he will pass away"**

(James 4:14) **"... whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow.
For what is your life? It is a vapor that appears for a little time
and then it vanishes away."**

(1 Peter 1:24-25) **"All flesh is as grass, and all its glory as the flower of the grass.
The grass withers, and its flower falls away, the word of the Lord endures forever"**

(Hebrews 9:27) **"And as it is appointed for men to die once,
but after this the judgment"**

(Ecclesiastes 9:5) **"For the living know that they will die,
but the dead know nothing ... "**

(Proverbs 27:1) **"Boast not about tomorrow,
for you do not know what a day may bring forth."**

(Isaiah 38:1) **"In those days Hezekiah was sick and near death. Isaiah the prophet,
the son of Amoz, went to him and said to him, Thus says the Lord:
Set your house in order, for you shall die and not live."**

(Job 7:6) "My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle ... "

(Job 10:20-21) "Are not my days few? Cease. Leave me alone, that I may take a little comfort, before I go to the place from which I shall not return"

(Job 14:1-2) "Man who is born of woman is of few days and full of trouble. He comes forth like a flower and fades away. He flees like a shadow and does not continue"

(Psalm 90:9-10) "For all our days have passed away in Your wrath, we finished our years like a sigh. The days of our lives are 70 years: and if by reason of strength they are 80 years, yet their boast is only labor and sorrow, for it is soon cut off, and we fly away."

(v12) "So teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom."

(Psalm 103:15-16) "As for man, his days are like grass, as a flower of the field, so he flourishes, for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place remembers it no more."

(1 Kings 2:1-2) "Now the days of David drew near that he should die, and he charged Solomon his son, saying, I go the way of all the earth ... "

(1 Chronicles 17:11) it is recorded that God has Nathan saying to David, "And it shall be, when your days are fulfilled, that you must go to be with your fathers, that I will set up your seed after you ... "

Every tombstone testifies that someone lived, died, and is lovingly remembered.

There isn't a tombstone for God.

2. SCRIPTURES TESTIFY TO AN ETERNAL GOD

(Genesis 21:33) "Then Abraham ... called on the name of the Lord, the everlasting God."

(Psalm 90:2) "Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever You had formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God."

(Romans 1:20) speaks of "His eternal power and Godhead"

(Romans 9:5) calls Him "the eternally blessed God"

(1 Timothy 1:17) "Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen."

The crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus was already pre-known by God:

(Acts 2:22-24) "Men of Israel, hear these words:
 Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders,
 and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as
 you yourselves know - Him, being delivered by the determined purpose
 and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands,
 have crucified, and put to death; whom God raised up ... "

3. GOD OFFERS ETERNAL SALVATION TO US

(Titus 2:11) "For the **grace of God that brings salvation** has appeared to all men"

(1 John 5:13) "These things I have written to you who believe
 in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life ... "

(John 20:30-31) "And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His
 disciples, which are not written in this book; **but these are written**
 that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God,
 and that believing **you may have life in His name.**"

So, apostle Paul says in (Romans 1:16) "For I am not ashamed of the
 gospel of Christ, for **it is the power of God unto salvation**
 for everyone who believes ... "

The message of the gospel must be obeyed: (1 Peter 1:22-23)

"Since **you have purified your souls in obeying the truth** through the Spirit
 in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart,
having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible,
through the word of God, which lives and abides forever."

(John 17:17) "**Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.**"

4. GOD OFFERS TWO ETERNAL DESTINIES

(Matthew 25:46) "And these will go away into everlasting punishment,
 but the righteous into eternal life."

(Mark 16:15-16) "And He said to them, 'Go into all the world and preach
 the gospel to every creature. **He who believes and is baptized will be saved**'"
