NAMES OF GOD

INTRODUCTION - in the O.T., God's people loved to celebrate God when He intervened in their lives in unexpected ways.

They would give God a name that had meaning to them in the light of the experience they had just been through.

1. JEHOVAH-JIREH: The Lord Will Provide

(Genesis 22:13-14) "And Abraham called the name of the place: The Lord ("Jehovah" / "Yehweh") will provide ("Jireh"), as it is said to this day ... "

2. JEHOVAH-RAPHA: The Lord Who Heals

The Israelites made the exodus from Egypt, crossed the Red Sea, and on their way to the promised land; however, they came to Marah, and "they could not drink the waters of Marah."

(Exodus 15:23-26) (v26) "For I am the Lord ("Jehovah") who heals you ("Repha"). "

3. JEHOVAH-NISSI: The Lord Is My Banner

(Exodus 17:11-12) "Joshua defeated Amalek" (v15) "Moses built an altar and called its name: The Lord (Jehovah") Is My Banner ("Nissi") "

4. JEHOVAH-M'KADDESH: The Lord Who Sanctifies

One theme in Leviticus is: (Lev. 11:44) "Be holy, for I am holy." (Leviticus 20:7-8) "... keep My statutes, and perform them: I am the Lord ("Jehovah") who sanctifies you ("M'Kaddesh"). "

5. JEHOVAH-SHALOM: The Lord Who Is Peace

(Judges 6:22-23) "... So Gideon built an altar there to the Lord, and called it, The Lord ("Jehovah") Is Peace ("Shalom"). "

6. JEHOVAH-ROHI: The Lord Is My Shepherd

(Psalm 23) "The Lord ("Jehovah") is my Shepherd ("Rohi") ... " Attributes of the Shepherd: "makes me ... leads me ... restores ... with me ... comfort ... anoint my head ... goodness ... "

NAMES OF GOD

1. **ADONAI - The Lord, My Great Lord**
(Psalm 8; Isaiah 40:3-5) God is the Master and majestic.
2. **EL - The Strong One**
(Exodus 15:2; Numbers 23:22) More powerful than any false god.
3. **EL ELOHE YISRAEL - God, the God of Israel**
(Exodus 5:1) God is separate and distinct from all false gods of the world.
4. **EL ELYON - The God Most High**
(Psalm 78:35; Acts 16:17) He is the Sovereign God; supremacy over false gods.
5. **ELOHIM - The All-Powerful One**
(Genesis 1:1-3; Deuteronomy 10:17) God is Creator; the plural of "El"
6. **EL OLAM - The Eternal God, Everlasting God**
(Psalm 90:1-2; Isaiah 40:28) The beginning and the end; throughout the ages.
7. **EL ROI - The God Who Sees Us.**
(Psalm 139:7-12) No circumstances in our lives can escape His awareness and care.
8. **EL SHADDAI - The All-Sufficient One; God Almighty**
(Genesis 17:1-2, 48:3) God is the source of all our blessings.
9. **IMMANUEL - God With Us; "I AM"**
(Isaiah 7:14, 8:10; Matthew 1:23) Jesus is God in our midst; fullness of Deity.
10. **JEHOVAH - "I Am;" The Self-Existent One.**
11. **JEHOVAH-JIREH - The Lord Will Provide**
(Genesis 22:13-14) God provided a Son to meet our spiritual needs.
12. **JEHOVAH-MEKADDISHKEM - The Lord Who Sanctifies**
(Exodus 31:12-13; 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24; Hebrews 13:12; 1 Peter 1:15-16)
God sets us apart as a chosen people; a people of His own.

13. **JEHOVAH-NISSI - The Lord Is My banner**
(Exodus 17:15-16; Deuteronomy 20:3-4; Ephesians 6:10-18)
God gives us victory against the flesh, the world, and the devil.
14. **JEHOVAH-RAPHA - The Lord Who Heals**
(Exodus 15:25-27; Psalms 103:3; 1 Peter 2:24) God provided a final cure.
15. **JEHOVAH-ROHI - The Lord Is My SHEPHERD**
(Psalm 23) God tenderly takes care of us as a strong and patient Shepherd.
16. **JEHOVAH-SABAOTH - The Lord of Hosts; Lord of Armies**
(1 Samuel 17:45-46; Psalm 46:7; Romans 9:29)
The Lord of Hosts of heaven will always fulfill His purposes.
17. **JEHOVAH-SHALOM - The Lord is Peace**
(Numbers 6:22-27; Judges 6:23; Hebrews 13:20)
God can bring us inner peace and harmony.
18. **JEHOVAH-SHAMMAH - The Lord Is There; The Lord My Companion**
(Psalm 46; Matthew 28:20) God's presence is not limited or contained in the Tabernacle or Temple, but is accessible to all who love and obey Him.
19. **JEHOVAH-TSIDKENU - The Lord Our Righteousness**
(Jeremiah 23:5-6; 2 Corinthians 5:21) God imparts righteousness to us.
20. **YAH, or JAH - "I Am," The One Who is the Self-Existent One**
(Exodus 3:14 and 15:2; Psalm 46:1 and 68:4; Isaiah 26:4)
God never changes. God promises His continuing presence.
21. **YHWH - "I AM," The One Who is the Self-Existent One**
(Exodus 3:14; Malachi 3:6) God never changes; promises never fail.

(Exodus 15:2) "The Lord is my strength and song, and He is become my salvation:
He is my God ... "

(Deuteronomy 7:9) "Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God,
the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those
who love Him and keep His commandments."
