(John 17:3) "... THAT THEY MAY KNOW YOU ... "

INTRODUCTION - I know that I cannot know everything about God.

(Isaiah 55:8-9) "... so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts ... "

(Psalm 145:3) "... and His greatness is unsearchable."

(Isaiah 40:28) "... His understanding is unsearchable."

(Romans 11:33) "... How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways ... "

(Ephesians 3:8) "... the unsearchable riches of Christ ... "

(Deuteronomy 29:29) "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever ... "

1. JESUS PRAYED FOR US TO KNOW GOD - (John 17:3) "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ ... "

Apostle Paul testified to this: (Ephesians 3:14 - 19) "... that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width, and length, and depth and height - to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that you may be filled with the fullness of God"

2. IF WE DO NOT "KNOW God"

1) We will become like whatever we worship: (Proverbs 4:23 and 23:7)

2) We will reap eternal separation from God: (2 Thessalonians 1:7-10)

3. WE ARE MADE TO "KNOW GOD" - (Psalm 46:10 and 62:5-8)

1) God revealed Himself in creation: (Psalm 19:1 and Romans 1:20)

2) God revealed Himself in His Word: (John 20:30-31)

4. WE ARE ENCOURGED TO "KNOW GOD" - (Psalm 27:4 and 100:3)

(2 Peter 1:2-3, v5-6, v8, and 3:18)

CLOSE: (Jeremiah 9:23-24) "... But let him who glories glory in this: that he understands and knows Me, that I am the Lord, exercising loving-kindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight, says the Lord."
